

The Bucks have, since the 1950s, been very active in tracing the family history and some members of the family still live on the old Matthew Buck farm.

All local members of the family are welcome to join us for a visit to the farm, discussions and sharing of family memories and information, tours of the local churches and cemeteries where family members have been interred, and some good food and fun. Cook's Corner

CABBAGE CASSEROLE

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED

1 head cabbage,

2 cups milk

coarsely chopped

4 eggs

Cheddar cheese

1 lb sausage, partially cooked and crumbled

HERE'S WHAT YOU DO

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Place chopped cabbage in a large shallow baking dish (be sure to grease or spray to keep clean up easy). Beat eggs and milk together until blended. Pour egg mixture over cabbage. Top with crumbled sausage. Bake until eggs are set and cabbage is tender. Put a layer of cheese on top and return to oven until melted.

This recipe can be adjusted to serve a couple or a crowd depending on how much cabbage you use, but if you are making a large quantity, bake in two or three dishes, so it will get done and not burn.
